Title: Recommended Training for Operational Chief Officer

Purpose: The purpose of this policy is to establish recommended standards of training for Battalion Chiefs assigned to an emergency operations role.

Policy: It is the recommendation of the San Mateo County Fire Chiefs that all chief officers permanently assigned to an emergency operations role in any county fire agency obtain the training outlined in this policy.

Procedures:

1. Recommended standards of training for operational chief officers shall be as follows:
